## STONE AN AVOCADO



- 1 With a chef's knife, slice around the avocado lengthways, cutting all the way around the edge of the stone.
- 2 Gently twist the halves of avocado in opposite directions and separate them from one another as cleanly as possible.
- 3 Strike the cutting edge of your knife into the stone and lift the knife (and pit, if necessary) to remove it from the avocado.

## PREPARE WHOLE ARTICHOKE



- 1 Holding the stalk to steady the artichoke, cut the tough tip off with a pair of strong kitchen scissors.
- 2 Use a chef's knife to cut the stalk from the base of the artichoke. The stalk can be tough, so get the artichoke firmly on a board.
- 3 Cut off the pointed tip of the artichoke and pull away any side or ear leaves that are tough. The whole artichoke is now ready to cook.

## REMOVE AVOCADO FLESH



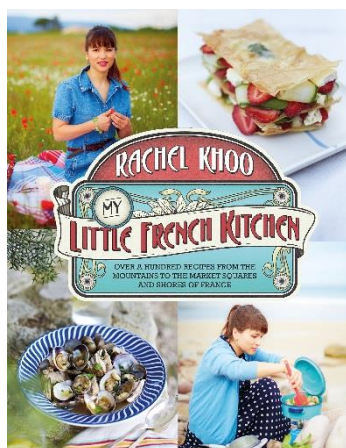
- 1 Holding the skin out of the avocado carefully, use the stone fork to pry the flesh away. Use a wooden spoon to scrape. Discard the stone.
- 2 Scoop the avocado meat away with a spoon. Use the skin as a guide, and the skin away from the flesh. Discard the skin.
- 3 To dice the avocado, cut it into small pieces. To chop, then chop it roughly to the desired size.

## PREPARE ARTICHOKE HEARTS



- 1 Cut or pull away all of the leaves from the whole artichoke. Then cut the cook from the base and discard.
- 2 With a sharp knife, cut off the soft middle of the heart just above the hairy chokes. Rub the flesh with lemon to reduce browning.
- 3 Trim away the heart on bones with a paring knife. Scrape out the hairy chokes if you wish to cut the heart into pieces for cooking.
